



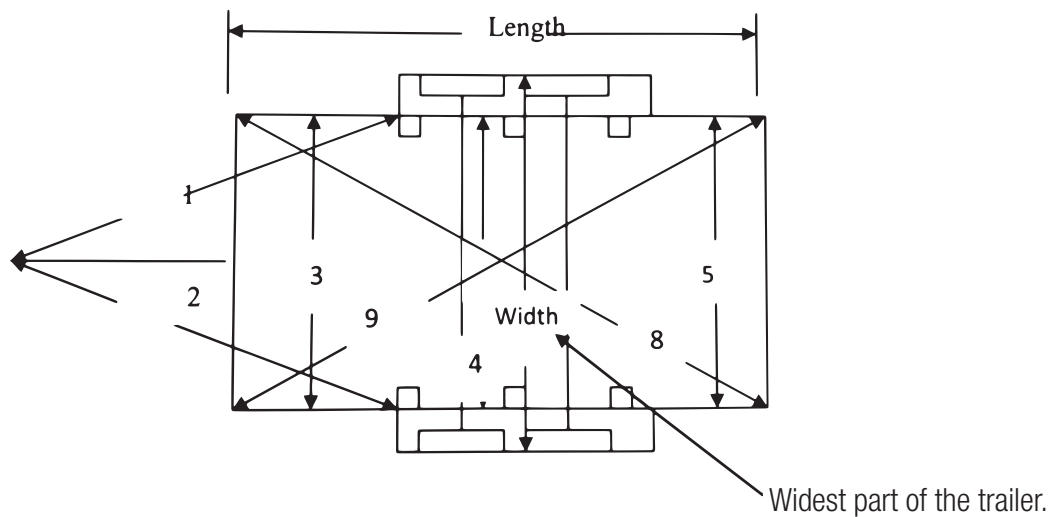

Lines 1 and 2 are measured from front spring hanger to ball socket (Determines center of hitch).

Difference in lines 1 and 2 to the nearest 1/4 inch _____

Lines 3-4-5 (Determines trueness of bed width).

Difference in lines 3-4-5 to the nearest 1/4 inch _____

Lines 8 and 9 are the diagonals. (Equal length indicates squareness) Differences _____
